Dear Parents and Carers

Following your conversation with the school today, I am writing to confirm that there has been a further positive test for Covid-19 within the school community. As your child has been identified as within close contact of this individual within 48 hours of development of symptoms, we have been advised by Public Health England that your child needs to self isolate for 14 days from the date of last contact, which was **Thursday 12th November**. The 14 day period of isolation will therefore end at the close of day on **Thursday 26th November**. If your child is well at the end of the 14 day period of self-isolation, then they can return to usual activities and attend school from **Friday 27th November**.

Other members of your household can continue normal activities provided your child does not develop symptoms within the 14 day self-isolation period. For further details please follow the PHE Staying at Home Guidance :

If during the period of isolation your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, **you should organise for your child to be tested** via the [NHS online portal](#) or by calling 119. Your household should isolate until you receive the test results giving the all clear. If you are unable to book a local slot then you can email d-ccg.devon.urgenttesting@nhs.net making clear that the test is for a child attending a Devon School, and you will be supported to access local testing. The symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are a recent onset of:

- A continuous cough and/or
- A high temperature and/or
- A loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19

Do:

- wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds

- use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- wear a face covering when you cannot maintain a 2m social distance
